



Council Approves Five Year Plan Revisions and FFY 2018 Action Plan

May 3, 2017

During its April meeting, the DD Council revised its Five Year Plan and approved its [Action Plan for Federal Fiscal Year \(FFY\) 2018](#). Highlights of the Council's FFY18 Action Plan include goals to continue to support advocacy and self-advocate leaders; advocate for further shifting of resources from institutional to community-based services; specialized training and technical assistance for community providers; and increase inclusive, evidence-based education policies and practices. New activities added to the FFY18 Action Plan include an Advocacy Leadership Conference, training and technical assistance for individuals participating in self-direction of waiver services, and capacity building of supported employment providers in underserved areas serving individuals with the most substantial employment support needs. The Council also removed two goals from its FFY17-FFY21 Plan related to child care and after-school programs and transition planning for young adults.
