

ACTION ALERT #18 - Contact Your Senator to Support Disability Services



The Senate Finance Committee passed the proposed State Budget for FY17 (HB1) restoring funding for many disability services cut by the House. Funding was restored to the following services and programs:

- Children's Choice, Supports, and Residential Options Waivers
- Long Term Personal Care Services (LT-PCS)
- Pediatric Day Health Care Program
- Human Services Districts/Authorities (Funding restored to the level originally proposed in the Executive Budget. However, the Districts/Authorities are still underfunded.)

The current version of HB1 includes:

- \$170,000 cut to Families Helping Families Centers
- No funding to pay overtime for Direct Support Professionals
- No funding to fill vacant waiver slots for those on the waiting list

Advocates very much appreciate the Finance Committee's restoration of the cuts made by the House. The budget will now be considered by the Full Senate this week. The current proposed budget may be viewed as the best case scenario for people with developmental disabilities considering the state's remaining \$600 Million budget shortfall. However, there are still many remaining unmet needs of people with developmental disabilities that can only be addressed if the Legislature raises additional revenue in the Special Session.

Contact your personal State Senator to let them know how you feel about the current version of the proposed budget and the remaining unmet needs that must be addressed in the Special Session.
