They spent ACT 378 funds on 5 families in April for Drivers education, groceries, rent and utilities

NWLHSD utilized funds for clothing for one child, one request for rental payment and one request for car insurance for parent was paid CLHSA used funds on rent for one youth/family, 10 riding sessions for one child, utilities, food, equipment for boy scout camp

\*\* NEDHSA has not provided reports for April and May in spite of OBH requests/expectation to do so Materials were purchased for art activity for youth for Mental Health Awareness Day, for therapy materials and for end of year event.

JPHSA spent the funds on membership fees to boys and girls club. There is a two dollar difference in their YTD FPHSA reported that funds were spent on a utility bill, rent, summer, art and football camps.
