

Information Alert - DHH Seeks Feedback on Managed Care for Long-Term Supports and Services

Managed care for long-term supports and services is coming to Louisiana. The Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) has released a concept paper outlining its initial plan for transforming the current system.

Now DHH wants to hear from you!

The concept paper contains only a basic framework for the creation of a new managed long-term supports and services (MLTSS) program and notes several areas in which DHH is seeking public feedback (bolded throughout the document).

Here is an opportunity to give your opinion on many decisions yet to be made including:

- Should all populations be transitioned to MLTSS at the same time?
- Should all populations be served by the same managed-care organization?
- Which services should be included in the scope of the MLTSS?
- How should quality be measured?
